

Collaboration between QLASH and Flamengo for the Brawl Stars Master League



The Brazilian club will participate in the Brawl Stars competition with QLASH's roster after an agreement between the two clubs.

The Brawl Stars Master League will gather 13 of the most relevant football clubs in Latin America. The event has a 100,000 dollars prize pool, and Flamengo will be participating with the collaboration of QLASH.

Thanks to an agreement between both organizations, the Brazilian players Sinval, Lele and Guido, and Chilean coach Raúl will be on loan from QLASH to Flamengo Esports to compete in the Brawl Stars Master League, which will be played during the last quarter of 2021.

This collaboration agreement is made during QLASH's process of expansion to Latin America and as part of continued work of the esports organization with football clubs, such as Italian AC Milan - creating the brand AC MILAN QLASH (AQM)- and Spanish Villarreal CF.

Flamengo will be competing against clubs such as Corinthians from Brazil, Boca and River from Argentina, America and Chivas from Mexico, Atletico Nacional and America de Cali from Colombia, Liga de Quito from Ecuador, Cerro Porteño from Paraguay, Nacional from Uruguay, Universidad de Chile and Universitario from Peru.

Also, the players and coach will continue to compete representing QLASH in other Brawl Stars competitions like Brawl Stars Championship and Queso Cup during the next three months.

With this action, QLASH begins its expansion process to Latin America, which has a new announcement in scope for the next months aiming to consolidate as club and brand in the region in 2022.
